Institution's Effort for an Inclusive Environment

- Promoting Culture:** The college is trying to promote Bhadu Song and Bhadra-Culture which had been originated in Kashipur, Purulia where the college is located. The College has introduced a "Diploma Course on Manbhumer Lokogan O Bhadu" from the 2018-19 Academic Session with affiliation from Sidho-Kanho-Birsha University, Purulia. 50 seats are allotted for this course. An international seminar also held on Bhadu in 2018.
- Course on Santali:** Kashipur M. M. Mahavidyalaya is situated in a rural area of the Purulia district of West Bengal where more than 65% of people belong to Other Backward Classes (OBC), Scheduled Caste (SC), and Schedule Tribe (ST). For these ST people, Alchiki is the main language of the Santali people. This college introduced Santali as one of the main subjects of B.A. Program Course in 2015. Since then, students' participation in B.A. in Santali is increasing in every academic session.
- Hool Divas:** Hool Divas has been observed every year to give importance to the Santali people of the region on 30th June. This program was observed in the last academic year on 30.06.2023.
- Annual Cultural Competition:** Every year annual cultural competition is held and local culture including Santali song and dance, Bhadu song, recitation and play in Kurmali language etc are a part of the program.
- Wall Magazine Competition:** College gives importance on preservation of culture and lifestyles of Purulia district during annual wall magazine competition held every year. A panel of judges take the decision on ranking of the magazines and awarded.
- National Seminar:** The Department of English was organized a National Level Seminar on “The Saga of Unsung Tribal Heroes of Freedom Movement of India Projected In History, Literature and Print Media”.
- Courses on Kurmali Language:** College is planning to open the UG Courses in Kurmali language (language of the OBC people especially Mahato community) from the next to next academic session (2024-25).
