## Modalities of the Assessment of Theoretical/Practical Courses

## Major papers

Case 1: $(5+0+1)$ credit course i.e. Theoretical (T-Type) papers (Full Marks 90 with distribution Theory 75, IA 15)

- 75 marks in theoretical part will be assessed in end semester examination
- IA 15 marks be assessed through continuous evaluation by Internal teachers only.

Case 2: $(4+2+0)$ credit course i.e. Combined (C-Type) papers
(Full Marks 90 with distribution Theory 60, Practical 30 )

- 60 marks in theoretical part will be assessed in end semester examination
- Practical 30 marks be assessed through continuous/external/internal Evaluation.

Case 3: $(0+6+0)$ credit course i.e. Practical ( S -Type) papers (Full Marks 90)

Marks may be distributed as under
i. Internal Assessment : 15 marks
ii. Viva : 05 Marks
iii. Experiment : 70 Marks

## Minor papers

Case 1: $(3+0+1)$ credit course i.e. Theoretical (T-Type) papers (Full Marks 50 with distribution Theory 40, IA 10 )

- 40 marks in theoretical part will be assessed in end semester examination
- IA 10 marks be assessed through continuous evaluation by Internal teachers only.

Case 1: $(2+2+0)$ credit course i.e. Combined (C-Type) papers
(Full Marks 50 with distribution Theory 30, Practical 20 )

- 30 marks in theoretical part will be assessed in end semester examination
- Practical 20 marks be assessed through continuous/external/internal Evaluation.

Case 4: $(0+4+0)$ credit course i.e. Practical ( S-Type) papers (Full Marks 50)

Marks may be distributed as under
iv. Internal Assessment: 10 marks
v. Viva :05 Marks
vi. Experiment : 35 Marks

## For 40 Marks:

Objective/ MCQ type 10 no X 1 marks $=10$ marks

Broad type $\quad 1$ no X10 marks= 10 marks (Out of 3 options. Question may be segmented)

For 30 Marks:
Objective/ MCQ type 10 no X 1 marks $=10$ marks

Short type 2 no X 5 marks $=10$ marks (Question may be segmented)

## For MDC/VAC Courses :

MDC ( 50 Marks) - 25 No MCQ type questions to be set. Each question carrying 2 marks having 4 options.
